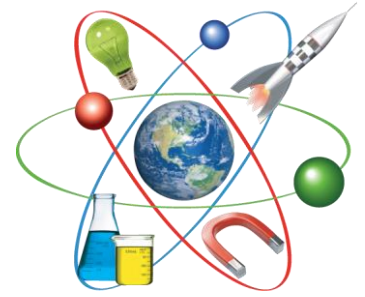


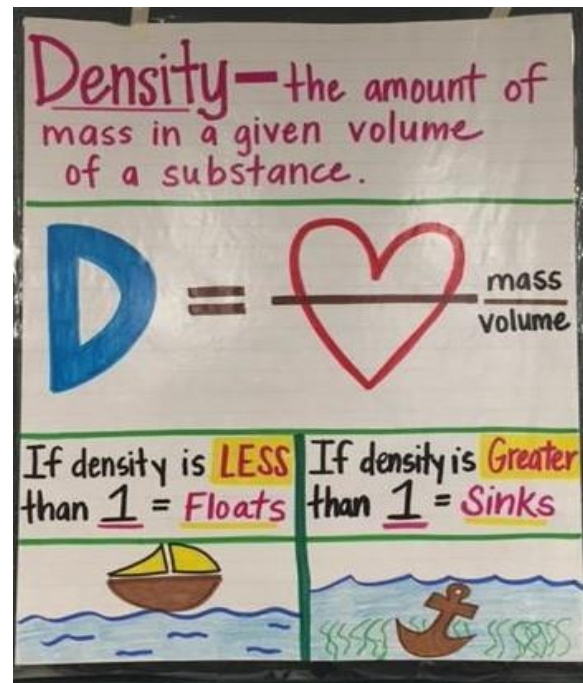

October 6, 2017: Week 7

This week in science, students learned how to calculate density using the formula $\text{Density} = \text{Mass} / \text{Volume}$. Students conducted a Density lab where they had to first find the mass using a triple beam balance, and use water displacement to find the volume. Once students found these two measurements, students were able to find the density of various objects.
